Kindergarten Registration for the 2025-2026 School Year

Kindergarten registration for the 2025-2026 school year will open on Monday, February 3, 2025. The standardized age of entry requires students to turn five years old by December 31 of the school year they begin Kindergarten. This means children born between Jan. 1 and Dec. 31, 2020 can register for Kindergarten for the 2025/26 school year. All registration must be completed online. Paper application forms are no longer available.

New RVS Families: To register a child for Kindergarten, please create a new SchoolEngage account.

Current RVS Families: To register a new child for Kindergarten, login to the <u>PowerSchool Parent Portal</u> and access SchoolEngage on the left-hand menu.

Parents with age eligible children are encouraged to register as soon as possible so that plans for next year can be made with the most accurate numbers in mind. If you or anyone you know requires assistance with the registration process, please feel free to come into the school.
