### **Report Cards**

With year-end approaching, teachers are once again busy assessing their students and inputting grades and comments into PowerSchool. We want to take the opportunity to remind you that a child's learning is cumulative and not all learning outcomes are 'graded' equal. Teachers prioritize outcomes they feel are necessary for success in the next grade; literacy and numeracy skills continue to be our focus. Therefore, you may notice your child's 'grades' change as teachers start to input the more heavily weighted cumulative outcomes. As report cards are now digital click <a href="here">here</a> for instructions on how to view and print your child's report card. Report cards will be available on June 25, 2025. In the meantime, please continue to check PowerSchool for information regarding your child's progress and do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher should you have any questions.

### **Grade 5 Transition and Farewell**

The grade 5 transition is off to great start! Our Learning support Team met with Langdon School's team on May 23rd to discuss our kids, specifically those with SSP's. A small group of grade 5's went over on May 26<sup>th</sup> for a pre-tour, and on May 30<sup>th</sup> all of our 5's went to Langdon School for a tour and stayed to enjoy the Spring Band concert. On June 12<sup>th</sup> LS grade 5's will be joining us for our 'Granny Awards' play and then again on June 17<sup>th</sup> for a 'Picnic-n-Play'! And as a reminder, the grade 5 ceremony will follow the play (certificates and BBQ).

### Literacy and Numeracy Reassessments for Grades 1-3

Some students in Grades 1-3 who have been receiving intervention support in literacy and/or numeracy will be reassessed on one or more <u>provincial assessments</u> in late May to early June.

#### Please note:

- 1. **Not all students** will be reassessed.
- 2. **Kindergarten students** are not required to be reassessed.
- 3. Final data will be returned to RVS in August; your child's next-year teacher will have access to the information to make informed decisions about intervention supports needed.

Thank you for your understanding and support in our ongoing commitment to support student learning. If you are unsure if your child is being reassessed please reach out to their teacher.

### **Register Now to Save on Transportation Fees**

Rocky View Schools (RVS) has opened transportation registration for the 2025/26 school year through SchoolEngage. Parents/guardians are encouraged to register by June 30 to receive a \$40 discount or by Aug. 1 to ensure bus service for the first day of school.

In response to rising costs, transportation fees have increased for the coming school year. A list of fees is available on the <u>RVS website</u>. Families are encouraged to take advantage of the early registration discount to offset some of the transportation cost. Eligible families may also apply to have their transportation fees waived by completing a Transportation Fee Waiver.

The June 30 early registration discount of \$40 is extended to each of the first two Kindergarten – Grade 12 students in a family, with additional students receiving \$20 off if registering early. A minimum payment of 50 per cent is due at registration. Bus service may be cancelled up until Oct. 31 to receive a full refund for all fees paid.

Families are urged to register as soon as possible for transportation to ensure a smooth start to the fall. To guarantee service for the first day of school, registration must be received before Aug. 1. Students registered after this deadline may experience delays of two to three weeks before they can ride the bus.
